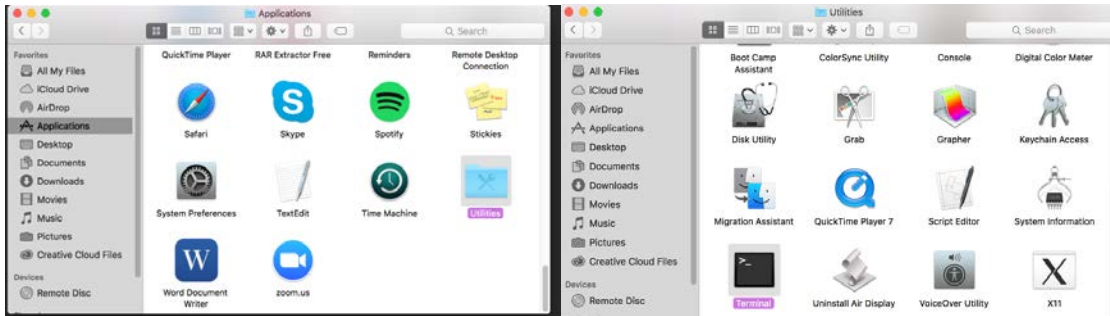
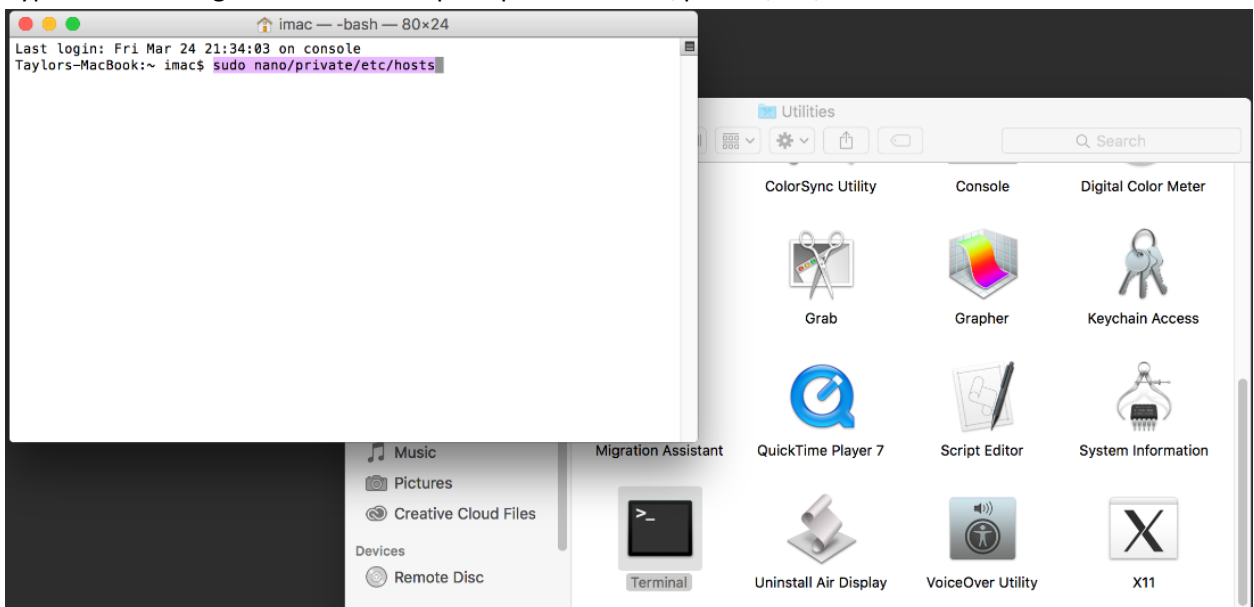


How to Update Your Hosts File on a Mac

1. Launch Terminal, found in /Applications/Utilities/ or launched through Spotlight



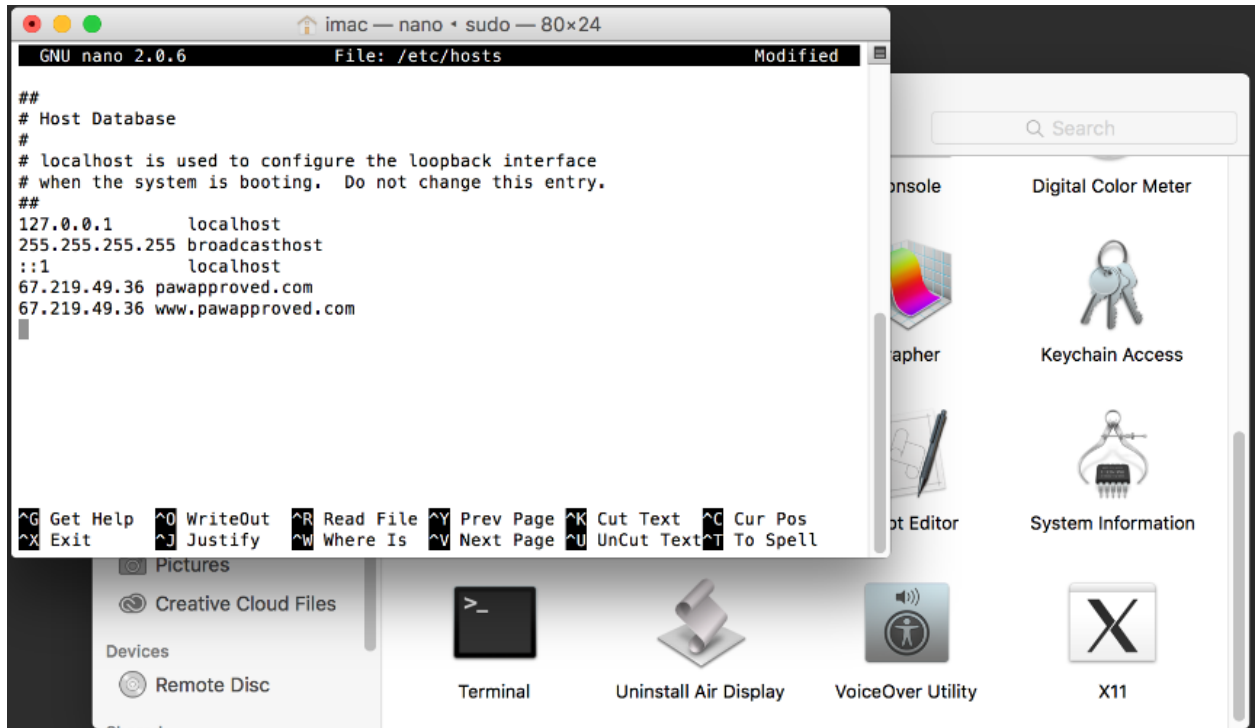
2. Type the following command at the prompt: `sudo nano /private/etc/hosts`



3. Enter the administrator password when requested, you will not see it typed on screen as usual with the command line



- Once the hosts file is loaded within nano, use the arrow keys to navigate to the bottom of the hosts file to make your modifications



- When finished, hit Control+O followed by ENTER/RETURN to save changes to /private/etc/hosts, then hit Control+X to exit out of nano
- Quit out of Terminal when finished
- When you want to view the original website again just add a # in front of your hosts entries
