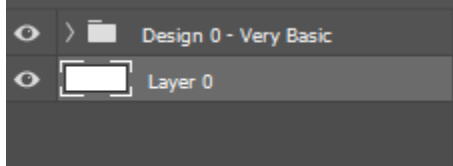
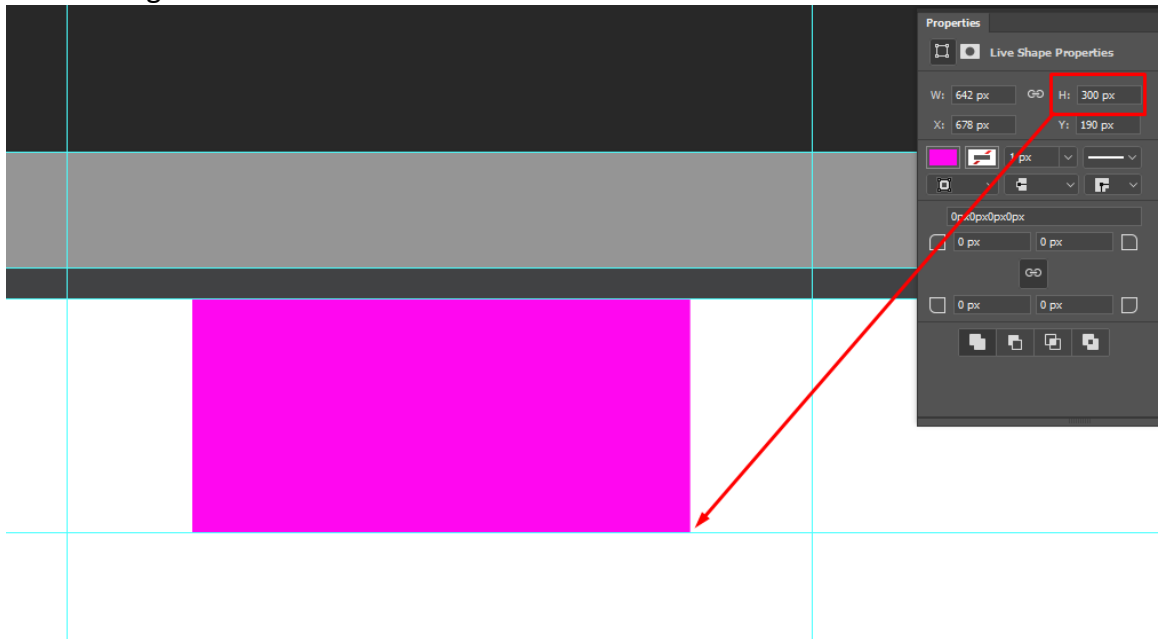


How to Make a One Image Full Width Banner for iPage

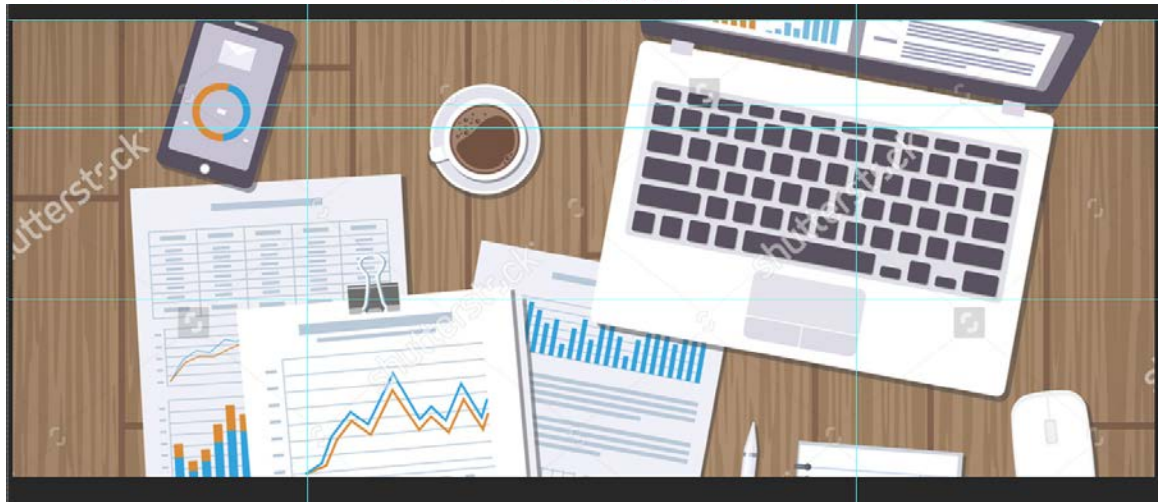
1. Open the basic full width template in photoshop (you can download that here: <http://ypcdesignerdocumentation.com/logos/basicfullwidthtemplate.psd>)
2. We're going to be using "Design 0 – Very Basic" for this example



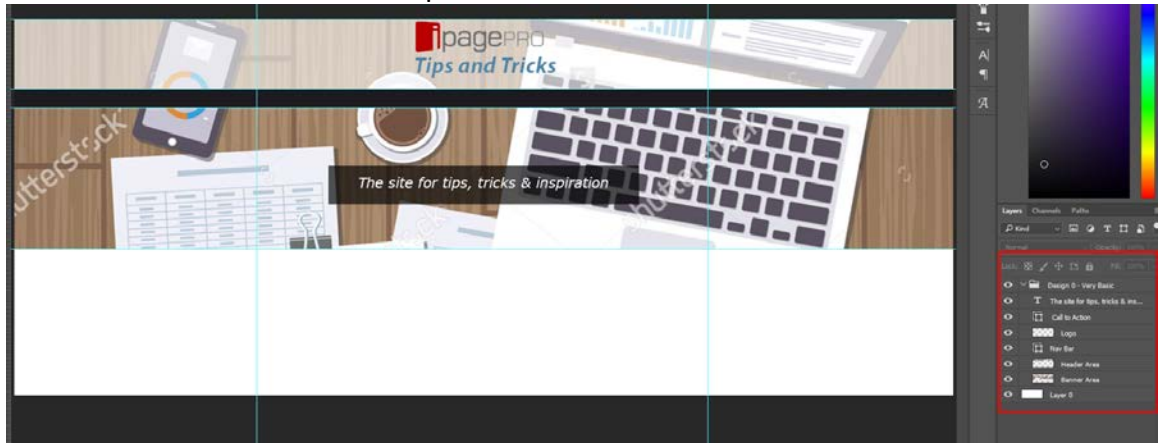
3. Decide how tall you want your banner to be – in this example I'm going to make it 300px tall – so I am going to insert a rectangle that is 300px tall so that I can create the guidelines that I need



4. Find an image that you think will work with the website – if you are not sure if the image will work you can always download a preview to test with



5. Now you can go through and start designing out the rest of the elements
 - a. Crop the sections that you don't need
 - b. Add in the Nav Bar
 - c. Add a call to action to the banner section
 - d. Make any other changes you feel are needed
6. This is what my final design looks like with its layers before cropping out the header and banner to save as separate files



7. Crop out the header and banner and save as separate files to add to the website – see this guide on how to do that
